

Greetings Nobles!

Thanks for sending my Lady and me to the Oriental Guide Training in Tampa. Imperial has a lot of good information and several ways to help each Shriner and each Temple. Two useful websites are Web Fez (webfez.shrinenet.com) and Shriner's Village (www.shrinersvillage.com) Both websites present information about your membership, ways to pay dues online and videos that help explain about our Hospitals and even tips about how to get new members.

Besides the intensive training sessions, we did get a chance to tour Imperial Headquarters and their little museum. There's such a lot of history in our

Fraternity and the museum can only show a little of it, but it's still impressive. If you ever get a chance, see the many displays and learn some of the impressive stories of the Shrine.

We also made a stop at the Clearwater Aquarium to say hello to Winter the Dolphin. Winter is the dolphin that lost her tail flukes while tangled in a fishing net. The aquarium rescued her and fitted her with a prosthetic tail fin that used some of the technology developed in our Shrine Hospitals. The aquarium and their partner lab shared other techniques they invented and now prosthetic users are made more comfortable by a layer of Winter's Foam, a kind of shock absorbing substance that prevents chafing. Winter is also an unofficial mascot of the prosthetic department at our Pasadena Medical Center.

Preparations are still in progress for our annual Spring Fling in May. It's always been a Sock Hop dance, but this year we're adding the theme of Cartoon Characters. Wear a cartoon themed outfit for any of the great animated shows of the past. It doesn't matter if it's our Potentate's mascot of Felix the Cat or the First Lady's Betty Boop. It could be a Loony Toons character like Bugs Bunny or Porky Pig, both voiced by Noble Mel Blanc. Example brick:




Presently the thought is to lay the bricks to the right of the Dedication Monument, two or three high horizontally.




