

MESSAGE FROM THE CHIEF RABBAN

This is the Chief Rabban's report of the proceedings of the Iowa Corporation from the 145th Annual Session of Shriners International. I first want to thank the nobility for sending Kim and I to Imperial Sessions in Nashville as your representatives. We had a marvelous time seeing our counterparts and many other Shriner friends, meeting new Shriners, voting on important legislation and candidates, and enjoying the great city of Nashville. The El Bekal ladies especially enjoyed the Ladies Luncheon where five Shriner patients sang and played musical instruments to entertain them. There were 711 lowa Corporation delegates registered for the session. There were 20 resolutions on the call for the Iowa Corporation. Two of the resolutions were withdrawn. Five resolutions involved temples either withdrawing or joining a Shrine Association and all passed. One was for a temple to change it's location and it passed. Another one was to revoke the charter of the Florida Shrine Association and it passed. Two resolutions passed concerning sending minutes and voting by electronic means. One gave Aahmes Shriners of Livermore, CA. exclusive jurisdiction in the country of Australia. Another now allows new temples in Mexico. Anezeh Temple in Mexico City had previously had the exclusive temple in Mexico. The passage of this resolution will mean El Zaribah and Al Bahr will likely lose members. Both of those temples spoke in favor of the resolution. Another that passed concerned Shrine Associations for Shrine Clubs. One that failed would have required nominating officers at the stated meeting before the election meeting. The resolution that allows a non-Shriner to drive a vehicle that requires a special license in a parade when there is no Shriner available passed. Resolutions that allow the Imperial Potentate to grant a special dispensation to allow a temple to take actions at a meeting held elsewhere than the location of the temple and one that allows the temple budget to be amended at any meeting of the temple were passed. The resolution that would have allowed special assessments to temples was soundly defeated. The last one concerned Shriners International and the Grand Lodge of Arkansas. In 2012 the Grand Lodge of Arkansas removed recognition of Shriners. Many Shriners were expelled, gave up their Shrine membership, or demitted to a lodge in another state that allowed them to join. In 2013 Shriners International voted to allow non-Masons in Arkansas to be Shriners to assist those that had been expelled to remain members and to allow new members to join their temples. The current Grand Master of Arkansas and Imperial Potentate Jim Cain have been working to restore fraternal relationships between the two organizations. The Grand Lodge of Arkansas and Shriners International have agreed to put together a working group to determine a plan for the restitution of relations and the restitution of the masonic prerequisite. The two Potentates in Arkansas, one a Mason and the other the first non-Mason Potentate, spoke in favor of the resolution. The resolution for a process to start restoring the fraternal relationship between the two organizations was overwhelming passed.

Jeffrey L. Sowder, Past Potentate of Midian Shriners in Wichita, Kansas was elected Imperial Potentate. Imperial Sir Jeff is the first Past Grand Master to be elected imperial Potentate, having served the Grand Lodge of Kansas in 1997. First Lady Cheryl's project is "Heroes Among Us". This is a program to support and enhance the efforts of our patient ambassadors to share their stories and raise the profile of our organization. In the election for Imperial Outer Guard, David Worel of Al Aska Shriners in Alaska was selected. He is a Past Grand Master of the Grand Lodge of Alaska. The 2020 Imperial Session will be held in Kansas City, MO.

I want to thank the nobility for selecting me as a voting representative, speaking of the Imperial Session it was well represented for El Bekal to the 2019 Imperial Sessions in Nashville, Tennessee. Lady Abeer and I had a great time visiting the different restaurants and libation stations. Great time with our fellow Divan members from across the Globe. As 85% of our children come to the hospitals for outpatient care, it is becoming more difficult to keep the hospital model, rather than medical centers and clinics. Only 17% of our hospital beds are being used.

Membership: "JUST ONE" is the motto of our new Imperial Potentate Jeff Sowder and going by that remember Nobles on August 24th we have a Ceremonial at the Shriners Medical Center. Lets each of us bring in "JUST ONE".

Last week at Imperial Session, they unveiled the new Imperial Potentate Jeff Sowder's "Just One" campaign to increase Shriner membership. A simple but powerful idea drives this initiative: If every current Shriner commits to recruiting or restoring "just one" noble to his temple, the ranks of our brotherhood will swell tremendously.

These are:

- Level 1 Upon creation or restoration of one member, the top-line signer will receive a postcard and Just One pin from Imperial Potentate Jeff Sowder.
- Level 2 Upon bringing in two members, the top-line signer will be listed in the Shriner Magazine.
- Level 3 With three new creations or restorations, the top-line signer will receive a certificate of appreciation and a letter of commendation from Imperial Sir Sowder.
- Level 4 After five creations or restorations, the top-line signer will receive a personal phone call from the Imperial Potentate.
- Level 5 Top-line signers responsible for 10 additional Shriner brothers will receive a special invitation to attend a Just One VIP reception with the Imperial Divan at the 2020 Imperial Session.

MESSAGE FROM THE HP&P

HP&P August Message

Greetings Nobles!

I'd like to address something that gets on my nerves. It really upsets me to see our Craft slandered and lies told about the Shrine. Okay, so you probably want to know what set me off, so I'll tell you.

A few days ago at a Masonic function, I was discussing the virtues of Shrinedom to a few Masons who could become prospects and maybe members of El Bekal. One of them piped up with "I'll never wear a red Fez!"

When I asked him why, he recited the horrid rumor that the Fez was red because it had been dipped in the blood of Templar Knights. I tried to correct him, but he

didn't want to hear any facts, he just refused to listen. So I'm going to share some facts here and hope the Nobles will find them useful.

* Some Facts About Fezzes*

The Nowadays is associated with Turkey, but didn't actually originate in that country. The Fez began as a head covering in ancient Greece and was adopted by the Ottomans when they conquered that country. The Arabs called it a Tarboosh, but it got its new name from the city of Fez, Morocco that produced the dark red dye from berries.

The Fez was worn by both sexes, especially in Cyprus where its color could be black, white or red. In Arabic countries, the Fez was often wrapped with a turban to give extra sun protection. In colder areas the Fez could be trimmed with fur.

In the 1820s, the Turkish military adopted the red Fez as their official headgear, part of a modernization effort. It was quickly adopted by civilian officials, but without the turban part. Other armies in the middle east and levant soon copied them and nearly caused a shortage of Fezzes. However a chemist in the Austrian Empire (a part that is now the Czech Republic) invented a synthetic red dye and the majority of Fezzes were soon produced there.

The Fez was popular for many years, used as military headgear in many armies and as an exotic cap by civilians. But in 1925, Kemal Ataturk banned the Fez in Turkey as part of his reforms.

Some militaries have kept the Fez to this day, but it is usually reserved for dress or parade uniforms and more protective gear is used in the field.

The red Fez became the official hat of the Shrine in 1872 and many other fraternal organizations wear Fezzes in all sorts of colors and different styles.

I hope you enjoyed this brief history of the Fez. There are many more places to find information about the Fez, starting with Wikipedia. There's also an online Fez museum with many examples of fraternal Fezzes.

Every Donation Makes a Difference

Shriners Hospitals for Children depends on the generosity of donors to fund all its programs, from telehealth to research to high-tech equipment, including EOS imaging and motion analysis centers. Here are brief descriptions of these highly important efforts:

TELEHEALTH

To help us provide care to our patients in an efficient, considerate manner, we continue to strengthen and expand our telehealth care program. This initiative allows patients to be seen at local affiliate locations, and uses real-time videoconferencing to connect the patient to Shriners Hospitals medical staff, reducing both the amount of time away from home and travel time. In 2017, more than 350 telehealth clinics were held, benefiting nearly 1,000 children. We expect to have all locations participating by 2019.

Our commitment to the development, refinement and implementation of a system-wide telehealth care network is just one more example of our determination to provide excellent, compassionate, innovative care to children in need of our services, wherever they may live.

RESEARCH

In 2017, Shriners Hospitals for Children provided funding for 141 research projects, two RFPs, 20 research fellowships and 15 Lemieux medical student internships. Our research projects generally involve discovering new knowledge that will increase understanding and improve treatments in our four service areas of orthopaedics, burn care, spinal cord injury, and cleft lip and palate. These efforts cover a wide range of themes, including the discovery of innovative methods that allow earlier diagnosis of sepsis, which is a major threat to patients with severe burn



injuries, as well as the development and testing of new drugs to stimulate bone formation to improve care for those with bone diseases.

EOS IMAGING

The EOS Imaging System is a Nobel Prizewinning technology that will produce life-size images with up to 85 percent less radiation compared with conventional X-rays. EOS provides full-body images of patients in a natural standing or seated position in both 2-D and 3-D. These weight-bearing images reveal a patient's natural posture and allow physicians to analyze the interactions between bones, joints and ligaments from different angles.

Research has indicated that radiation from repeated X-rays can increase the risk factor for cancer later in life. This is a great concern to our medical team, as Shriners Hospitals for Children is committed to providing the best and the safest treatment we can to our patients. Radiation exposure is cumulative over one's life span, so EOS imaging is particularly helpful for use with children who need multiple images taken throughout their course of treatment.

MOTION ANALYSIS

In our 14 motion analysis centers, highspeed cameras, reflective markers, force platforms and muscle sensors are used to record, measure and evaluate how a child with a mobility impairment - such as those caused by neuromuscular conditions like cerebral palsy, congenital challenges including clubfoot and spine problems such as scoliosis - actually moves. The data collected helps provide an understanding of the interactions between the child's muscles, joints and bones, which helps the patient's medical team create an effective care plan. When we understand these different gait and movement patterns, we can help those with mobility impairments to move more efficiently, more effortlessly and more confidently.

At Shriners Hospitals for Children, every patient receives individual attention and a care plan tailored to their specific needs. We do our best to provide a complete range of care and services that will allow our patients to recover to the fullest extent possible, and go on to achieve their goals and dreams. Our generous donors make this possible.

Just a brief update from Shriners For Children Medical Center – Pasadena. We are very pleased to announce that we have entered an agreement with the Children's Hospital of Los Angeles (CHLA). The current agreement gives our Shriners physicians the capability to perform complex surgical cases at CHLA and admit inpatients there. There is wonderful for our patients and families for it gives them access to a premier Children's Hospital environment right here in LA County. Just recently CHLA was rated as a top 5 Children's Hospital in the United States by US News and World reports and we are delighted to partner with them Not only should this inpatient partnership with CHLA give our patients access to the highest quality pediatric hospital in the area and a wonderful child friendly environment, we believe this will also save Shriners a good bit of expenses. Huntington Hospital, our inpatient partner up until now, did not have contracts with all of the payors that we do. This meant that in order to get inpatient services provided at Huntington Hospital, Shriners had to pay them on a per case basis. In contrast, CHLA has contracts with all of the payors we need them to. This will mean that our patients will get their inpatients services funded by their own insurance and not by Shriners for the most part. This should result in substantial savings and an opportunity to further reduce our draw on the endowment. All of this is just the first step in what will hopefully be an even larger partnership between Shriners For Children Medical Center For Children Pasadena and CHLA. As we speak we are working on a Memorandum of Understanding between the two institutions that would create the springboard for exploring other exciting ways that we could partner together to provide incredible care to children. This partnership has tremendous potential in brightening the lives of many, many children!! We will you apprised of any progress we make as we make it!!

Example brick:




Presently the thought is to lay the bricks to the right of the Dedication Monument, two or three high horizontally.
