Marius Woodward, is a true inspiration!

Marius was born in a small village in Romania.

In 2007, when he was only 8 years old, a family altercation resulted in a terrible house fire. Marius remembers escaping the flames through one of the windows and landing at the back of the house where a neighbor found him.

Marius had severe burns over 75 percent of his body, and had lost all of his fingers and his nose. The fire had also taken his parents; his siblings were spared, possibly only because they were not at home when the incident occurred.

Marius spent eight months at a hospital in Romania, where he met two students from Brigham Young University, Ashley Ludlow and Jessica Free, who were participating in a special program and visited the hospital. Realizing that the child would not receive all the care he needed in Romania,

the girls enlisted their families' assistance to bring Marius to the U.S.

Eventually, Marius was adopted by Ashley's family, the Woodwards, and began treatment at Shriners Hospitals for Children — Los Angeles, where he underwent many surgeries, including a multiple toe-to-hand transfer, which would allow him to be much more independent. Marius is believed to be the first in the world to have a transfer of this type involving six toes.

Today, Marius is an active 17-year-old high school student who, despite having only two toes and

six new fingers, is able to play football and soccer; his goal is to become a motivational speaker and a model, to demonstrate that his scars make him who he is and to encourage acceptance, despite outward appearance.

MESSAGE FROM THE ASSISTANT RABBAN





Visiting the facility even on a quiet day seemed a bit overcrowded, but we managed to complete our visit/tour. It was interesting to hear about how so many patients were accommodated with such a small facility. We then went to the big Hospital Angeles in downtown Tijuana, it was an education to see how Tijuana was a very modern city with the Shopping Centers and having new





cars as we have in the United States. There are some poverty areas, again, just as we have here.

The Hospital Angeles is simply amazing, all modern. Everywhere you look it is sparkling clean. There were no waiting lines to speak of. The Administrator told us that (waiting lines) were a big issue some



time ago, but was fixed with a more efficient scheduling program.



The Board of Governors had their meeting where it was disclosed that the Shriners would be moving into this facility by this year's end occupying 12 rooms.

Most of these rooms will be converted to Office and Examining rooms. Having the Hospital Angeles in the same building is a plus plus situation.





When the Shriners move into Hospital Angeles, even with the said 700 patients per month, it should relieve the pressure of the operation.



The hospital tour was given by the actual Hospital Director who was very detailed, there were not many questions when he was through. The entire day was time well spent having lots of information about where our future rest in respect to Tijuana.

What is an Ambassador?

The Ambassador is a unique role in El Bekal Shrine, relevant to the unique nature of the Shrine itself. They are called Ambassadors. As the name has changed so the role has evolved over the years and they are now a very important part of El Bekal Shrine structure.




