### **MESSAGE FROM THE ASSISTANT RABBAN**



Greetings Nobles!

I'm sure that we've all heard grumbling about one holiday or another being canceled this year because of health concerns related to the current virus pandemic. It's tough to get together safely and enjoy the large gatherings of family and friends that we were accustomed to in previous years.

But it's not true that the holidays themselves are canceled, those special days are still there and are still celebrated. It's just that we have to avoid the large gatherings that we're used to. Human ingenuity is much smarter than any virus. I've seen the clever ways that people have invented to still have a fun Halloween and some of those creative ideas can be used for other occasions. The most obvious is to host a Zoom, Skype or Livestream event to bring

everyone together online. With video providing the visual element of conversation, these get togethers are much closer to in-person meetings than a text or audio-only event could ever be. An added advantage to online gathering is that those who are unable to travel can still join in. I've experienced this myself at a recent family religious service, where the officiating Rabbi was in Chatsworth, much of the family was scattered around Southern California and relatives from as far away as New York and Alaska were able to participate.

While some of the schemes used for Halloween won't necessarily work for Thanksgiving, Christmas or Hanukah, such as colorful candy chutes and little candy catapults, there might be a way to adapt some of the other ideas and add even more. Drive-by visits, made even better when combined with admiring house decorations, can take the place of neighborhood visits and caroling. Curbside handoffs of food and treats can be done while maintaining a social distance.

Some of the professional Santas I know (and I seem to have several on my friends list) are not doing in-person appearances, but are sending personalized video messages to children on their "nice list." Others are showing up in a way that makes social distancing plausible, such as staying in a mock up sleigh or in one case, a giant plastic ornament ball. One Santa I know is experimenting with a tabletop animatronic Santa figurine equipped with a speaker and microphone to interact with the children. It's got a remote control that lets him select an appropriate gesture from the limited ones it can perform.

Hanukah is all about sharing light and we Masons can readily identify with that. A longstanding Hanukah tradition is to place a lit Menorah near a window so passerby can enjoy seeing the light. In the interest of safety, the Menorah in the window is usually an electric one, while the actual candles are placed safely away from anything flammable. Online events are well suited to a Hanukah celebration. The date of Hanukah varies because it's set by the Hebrew lunar calendar, not by the modern solar calendar. This year Hanukah starts at sunset on December 10.

Around this time the Hindus are also holding a festival that celebrates light. Diwali symbolizes the "victory of light over darkness, good over evil, and knowledge over ignorance." It lasts five days and the date varies because it's set by the Hindu lunar calendar (similar in nature to the Hebrew calendar.) This year Diwali starts on November 12th. Like other celebrations of light, it involves lit decorations, gifts and sweets. Special oil lamps called Diya are lit during Diwali and placed in rows, usually at the door of the house.

Now I'm not sure just how a traditional New Years Eve party can be done online. It's likely that someone has come up with a Zoom drinking game, but that's more for the college age crowd than for my tastes. At least with it being online, we don't have to worry as much about drunk drivers on the way home. The one New Years tradition that I still plan to follow is the midnight kiss with my wife, even if we have to set an alarm to wake us up.


