Potentate's Message for June 2022

Greetings Nobles & Ladies!

I've been asked why I keep mentioning the Ladies groups like Daughters of the Nile and Ladies' Oriental Shrine. I've also been asked why I keep mentioning Lodge and other Appendant Bodies of Freemasonry. Well, the answers to those questions are that Shrine has always been a part of Freemasonry and Masons always support our Ladies. The Lodge is the entry point for a man to become a Shriner, so it's the obvious place to begin looking for new members. Without Lodge, the Shrine wouldn't exist. Freemasonry is the foundation of the Shrine

and a good, solid foundation is essential to a robust structure. We must support our Lodges if our Shrine is to survive.

What's that got to do with the Ladies' groups? That's an easy one to answer. Without the support of our Ladies, we wouldn't be able to do what we do as Shriners. Also the Ladies have an advantage over Masons: they can start the conversation about Masonry and the Shrine with non-Masons, and even suggest that a man become a Mason. Here's my little secret: my Mother-in-law was the one that told me to start asking my Father-in-law about Lodge. Without her suggestion, I would never have become a Mason or a Shriner.

Another question I've been asked is why we're not holding as many events as we had before the recent shutdowns. Well there's this thing called inertia, something that scientists call Newton's First Law of Motion: a body at rest tends to remain at rest, while a body in motion tends to remain in motion. It's been nearly two years where no events were able to be held. Now it takes a lot of effort to overcome that inertia of not going to events. Too many of us are not in the habit of going out anymore. I'm certain that we can eventually overcome that, but it will take effort and just a little commitment from the Nobility.

So please make it a point to visit your Lodge, Chapter, or other Masonic meeting and talk about our El Bekal Shrine. Let them know about the upcoming events and especially let them know that they are invited. Don't forget to support your Club or Unit. Upcoming Events for El Bekal Shrine are:




