# **HIGH PRIEST & PROPHET**



#### Greetings Nobles,

Summer has come and gone and the fall is upon us now. Schools are starting to return to being in session. Please be mindful in your driving as there will be many children walking to and from school and out and about in the mornings and afternoons. In addition to schools starting, that also means Monday Night Football is back. Come out and join us Monday nights to watch football, enjoy great company, and eat lots of food for only \$5. Where else can you go anymore for a \$5 all you can eat meal? If you are not into football, we would still love to see you.

We also have a busy schedule of parades coming up this fall. After having the pleasure of finally riding in parades, representing the Shrine has been quite an honor. Growing up in La Habra, I lived just a block away from the parade route for the Corn Festival and I remembered always seeing the Shrine drive by making noise with sirens and horns and watching the Tin Lizzy's race around. Looking back, I would have never have thought that I will one day be in a Shrine car making all that racket and seeing excitement in the crowd.

I wasn't able to be at our July Stated meeting and give an update on our membership status, as it was my 13<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary. Maybe this will be a better forum to give an update so it reaches all of our members vs only those who attend stated meeting. We currently have 590 Nobles. We have recently had a few individuals inquire online, submit a petitions for membership, and are awaiting our next stated meeting to be voted in. There are also 132 individuals who have inquired about the shrine and are currently progressing through their degrees in the blue lodge or are currently petitioning a lodge. Sadly though, there is a reality of losing members. In the last two years, we have lost many who have retired to that lodge eternal in the heavens. This is a reality that is out of our control. What is in our control though, is recruiting new members and staying current on your dues. As of mid-July, we have 140 members who are behind in their dues. 86 of them are about to be suspended for nonpayment of dues. This is ranging with current 2022 dues up to a few nobles who are 5 years in arears. This has a shocking total of roughly \$36,000 in unclaimed dues. We had to pay about \$10,000 in per capita to Imperial Shrine over the course of these years for dues that went unpaid. If it was an unknown to you, the per capita charge is there regardless if you pay your dues or not. When you don't pay your dues, the temple has to pay out of its pocket. By the time this gets printed and distributed, 2023 dues will probably be applied to everyone.

To shine light on this bad news, there is hope. Noble Ridley has presented the Divan with a 5 year plan to help grow our Shrine and become more active in many ways. To quote or paraphrase another member of our temple, "If everyone replaced themselves with a new member, you doubled your membership." With Jim's idea of growing to over 1000 members, that shouldn't be hard to do if we all just replace ourselves. With more members comes more/new ideas, which creates new units/clubs. This can help to keep newly created Nobles interested in attending events or activities. I have said it in previous articles and I will say it again to challenge you: Go out and bring in new members! Membership growth falls on every member. Not just the membership committee.

We're extremely pleased to tell you that we are set to have a new Shriners Children's presence in Florida.

Jackson Health System, UHealth – University of Miami Health System, and Shriners Children's have a new affiliation to create Shriners Children's Orthopedic Center at UHealth Jackson Children's Care.

Shriners Children's Orthopedic Center will include a dedicated, signature space; new endowed chairs for pediatric orthopedics and pediatric physical medicine and rehabilitation; and a framework to advance world-class care for children with traumatic injuries and debilitating conditions.

In this setting, pediatric orthopedic clinicians will be working alongside other UHealth Jackson Children's Care signature pediatric services, which include organ transplant, cardiac care, neonatology, cancer treatment, neurosurgery, and more.

The commitment includes a new, state-of-the-art facility. Scheduled to open in 2025, the new building will be located steps from Holtz Children's Hospital.

The opportunity to connect more kids in more places to the specialty medical care they need, closer to home, is an important part of our organization's mission. With this agreement, children in South Florida and beyond will have a new and trusted option for their medical care.

## The El Bekal Shrine Tin Lizzie



The El Bekal Shrine Tin Lizzie unit was originally created as a group within the Valencia Shrine Club in 1962 and was converted into a regular parade unit of El Bekal on Oct. 11, 1982. It was formed for the purpose of having some fun while promoting the El Bekal Shrine efforts and Shrine Hospitals for Children through participation in various holiday parades throughout Southern California. The distinctive Tin Lizzie "Model T" cars are widely recognized and enjoyed by the parade spectators and are one of the first parade units that come to mind when someone mentions the "Shriner". The Tin Lizzies enjoy parading, and the unit participates in more parades than any other El Bekal unit. The Lizzies are real parade crowd pleasers with their antic filled driving style and wide variety of horns and other noisemakers. Their size also makes them particularly attractive to the children along the parade route. The El Bekal Lizzie unit is limited by its by-laws to 21 active regular members and cars for parade safety reasons plus other associate members who can act as substitute drivers. The unit currently participates in about eight to ten parades each year, with usually 8 to 12 cars at each parade. The El Bekal Tin Lizzie cars were originally required to look generally alike, specifically as small black "Model T" replicas with red trim plus one "tow truck". This look-alike strategy was originally done to enhance the chances of winning a parade participant prize/trophy, but since we have several trophies and no place to display them, we rarely actively compete for the parade prizes anymore. Consequently, the Bylaws have been relaxed somewhat with regard to the strict appearance and quantity of cars. The Tin Lizzie Ladies are also an important part of the unit, organizing various non-parade parties and events for the group as well as being with the guys at pre-parade breakfasts and after-parade parties. When the Ladies are found as a group among the parade spectators, custom dictates the Lizzie drivers to briefly stop as a group and acknowledge the Ladies with their noisemakers. All in all, the Lizziers have a lot of fun, both in parades promoting the Shrine cause and at our many non-parade events. This year's officers are Capt. Rick Schade, Lieutenant Mike Sekera, Treasurer Ron Michal, Secretary Ted Segerstrom. Our meeting night is the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of each month at the El Bekal Shrine Center in Anaheim, Ca. The first Friday in March each year, the Tin Lizzies host a fantastic country style Steak Fry BBQ dinner and unit fundraiser. It usually is sold out months in advance each year. With country dancing and live & silent auctions during the night with a drawing for the Grand prize! It's and event that the whole unit comes & works at each year.
