For our outing in February the Nomads traveled to Indio in support of the El Bekal Presidents Day activities, including the Date Festival parade. It was cool and breezy on the morning of the parade, but it was fun to represent the Shrine cause and purpose to an enthusiastic crowd of spectators.
