Final details for the 2020 El Bekal Cruise are not available yet. But the cruise itself has been finalized. The Enchanted Princess, which makes it's maiden voyage in June 2020, will sail from Barcelona, Spain on Saturday, September 5, 2020. The fantastic ports-of-call are Gibraltar, Marseille, France, Genoa, Italy and Florence/Pisa, Italy. The ship will arrive in Civitavecchia, Italy for our trip to Rome on Saturday, September 12. We have reserved 12 Balcony and 12 Interior Cabins, in addition to the Owner's Suite which Kim and I have reserved. We already have several couples signed up for the cruise at this early date. We are going through Cruise Holidays of upland. Our contact is Bonnie and her phone number is 909-946-6033. Refundable reservations can be made at this time through Bonnie. They are refundable until May 28, 2020. A small number of mini-suites are available at this time, but they may not last. Friday, September 11, 2020 Florence/Pisa, Italy

Saturday AM, September 12, 2020 Arrive at Civitavecchia, Italy and travel to Rome.

Saturday PM, September 12, 2020 Afternoon on your own. Evening dinner/night tour of Colosseum.

Sunday, September 13, 2020 All day tour of Rome.

Monday, September 14, 2020 All day tour of Vatican.

Tuesday, September 15, 2020 Fly home.

Except for the cruise, the rest of the schedule is not set in stone yet. We will arrange for the tours in Barcelona and Rome. Cruise excursions are on your own. There will be opportunities to gather in our suite at the back of the ship, which has a large balcony. Total cost of the trip has not been determined at this time. Assistant Rabban Message for May

Greetings Nobles,

It seems self-contradictory, but last month was an eventful month without any events. So many of our planned events were canceled or postponed by the stringent procedures necessitated by the Covid-19 Pandemic. While the precautions taken might seem to be unnecessary, we all have to remember that success in prevention is measured by bad things <u>not</u> happening. While we all miss seeing each other and having fun times at our Shrine, keeping a distance will let us stay safe and meet again when this is over.

Many of you know that I'm a history buff, with my having shot archery for years and making my own suit of chain-maille armor. By studying history, I've learned that humans have survived many plagues, epidemics and pandemics. The most famous, of course, is the Black Plague of the Medieval Era. So-called because of the black blisters caused by the disease, it was spread through infected fleas usually carried by rats. The practice of isolation helped slow the spread of this plague in some areas, and keeping a cat or two likely became more popular at this time, despite accusations of witchcraft. Something else that helped among a few communities, was simple cleanliness. Things we take for granted today like hand-washing, regular bathing and sanitation began more widespread popularity during this time. There are many illustrations (called illuminations) in hand-scribed documents that show people indulging in public bathhouses. Some of the pictures show people having a snack or playing games while bathing. Keeping clean was a community effort then, and I bet you thought communal hot-tubs were invented by the hippies of last century.

Another innovation that we take for granted today is access to clean water. The modern water supply, with its chlorination and other treatments is quite safe to drink. This wasn't always so, even as recently as the Civil War it was safer to drink water that had been boiled or contained enough alcohol to kill off microbes. Boiling was part of the process of making beer, coffee, tea and distilling hard liquor. Even children were given beer or other treated drinks. So you see, the Oasis in our Shrine is very important in keeping us healthy.

It seems strange to think that such mundane things as chlorinated water, flush toilets and hand washing with soap can keep us safe against an unseen danger like a virus or other microbe. But these simple things took many years to develop and they are still our best defense.

We all have heard it before and I think it is more relevant now. Time, patience and perseverance will accomplish all things.






