Illustrious Sir Al Turek, Divan and members of El Bekal Shrine, This letter will serve as my official resignation from the office of Assistant Rabban/ Acting Chief Rabban, effective immediately 12/13/22. This letter will also serve as my notification that I will not be running for the office of Potentate for the 2023 year. I would like to thank all the Divan for their support during the years that I have served this temple. I wish each of you luck in whatever endeavors are in your future. I believe that each of you have been chosen by the membership to represent them and make the best decisions for this temple. Unfortunately, I believe that there are a few members in

this temple that are determined to undermine the Divan's decisions and treat people in a manner that is in complete conflict with our masonic teachings.

I truly want what is best for this temple and I have always been vocal that contested elections only result in a division of the membership and an overall negative effect on the temple.

I challenge all the membership to look deeply to the actions of people who say one thing and then do something in complete conflict. I think that integrity is something that is necessary in a leader of this organization and I challenge you to look at the actions that do not reflect this virtue.

I want to assure you that this has not been a decision that has been easy for me to make and I have considered all options, but feel that I can no longer allow people to treat me and my family like this. I have worked hard to plan a great year, with a full calendar, gifts, theme, fez, jewel, clothing, etc. However, when I realized that while I was excited about planning a great year for this temple, there were people in this temple that were more interested in questioning my decisions, undermining my plans, and spreading untruths about me and my plans. I hope each person that reads this resignation understands that depth of this decision and instead of trying to figure out how to make this right for me, does what is right for the membership and helps ensure that future officers are not treated in this manner. We can no longer allow Divan members to be mistreated and ran off, as has been done on multiple occasions in this temple. You can no longer sit by and say, "Yes, that person is rude to everyone."

If you truly want what is best for this temple and all the members, you will find a way to ensure that people are supporting the leaders and activities and the people who have decided to always work against the officers and activities in this temple will be stopped. Every Past Potentate and his lady that I have spoken to has told me that they were treated the same. How many times have people been ran against other people, or at least that has been the threat? Why is it that the people who are poisoning this temple are also the people who are not attending events and figuring out how to support the officers of this temple, instead of always trying to break them down and destroy their events?

I think highly of every member of this Divan and only want was is best for you and the temple, but I hope that you will take my resignation as a call to action that you MUST join together and take this temple back from the people working so hard to destroy everything. You have been elected by the membership and I have witnessed from each of you that you are interested in the future of this temple, so please don't let it be destroyed by a few. We are stronger together than as a divided group.

I sincerely hope that my resignation will send the message that I want what is best for this temple and the entire membership and this will send a shockwave through the temple that will cause people to stop and remember their teachings, looking into other people's actions and ensuring that the temple is supporting their leaders and not breaking them and their activities down.

Don't let this resignation go without concern and action. I hope that this will not be something that continues to happen to future leaders.

§ 325.11 Election Regulations.

(a) **Electioneering.** The printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a Noble, suggesting, recommending, opposing or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited.

(b) Violation. For any violation of (a), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election.

(c) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section.
